Concert Band

March 30th - April 3rd

- Focus on Long Tones during warm up
- Be able to play the Concert Db Scale in the scale pattern
Expand your range, go for 2 octaves if possible!
- Be able to play “Island Empire March” and “Korean Hill Song”
- If you can, record yourself playing the concert Db scale (1 or 2 octaves, you choose) and email it to Mr. Howard at caleb.howard@claibornecsd.org

If you can not record and submit a playing test, you will be give time to make it up when we return to school.

April 6th - 9th (Good Friday/Easter Weekend)

- Focus on Tuning while doing Long Tones
Do this at different volumes with a tuner, making the tuning match
- Begin Learning the Concert Gb Scale
Concert: Gb, Ab, Bb, Cb, Db, Eb, F, Gb (6 flats)
Bb Pitch: Ab, Bb, C, Db, Eb, F, G (4 flats)
Eb Pitch: Eb, F, G, Ab, Bb, C, D, Eb (3 flats)
F Pitch: Db, Eb, F, Gb, Ab, Bb, C, Db (5 flats)
- Be able to play “Irish Tune From County Derry”

April 13th - 17th

- Focus on Dark/Rich tone during warm ups
Do this at different volumes and make your tone match at each level
- Be able to play your Concert Gb scale 1 quarter note per pitch
- Work on expanding your range with the scale
- Be able to play “When Summer Takes Flight”

April 20th - 24th

- Focus on Articulations during warm ups
Tonguing, Slurring, FortePiano, Sfz, and Accents
- Be able to play your concert Gb scale in the scale pattern
- Be able to play Lord Of The Rings
- Review **ALL** concert music.
We are still having the Spring Concert. (Date may be different than originally planned) More details will be given when we return to school and Mr. Howard has had time to make preparations.
