

LUNCHROOM

Breakfast and lunch are served every full day of school. Prices are announced at the beginning of each year, and application forms are made available to those who qualify for free/reduced meals. These may be obtained anytime throughout the school year if the family financial situation should change.

Lunchroom money should be sent in a sealed envelope, separate from any other money, and should have the student's name clearly marked on the outside along with the amount to be applied to breakfast/lunch. Parents are urged to pay for one or two weeks in advance; credit is extended for prepaid meals not eaten when the student is absent.

Students are allowed to buy extra items for breakfast or lunch if they have money in hand or a credit balance on their account. No a la carte items will be charged. If a parent does not want their child to have extras at all, that should be explained to the child and to the homeroom teacher, who can make a notation on the lunch form. (Please see new Claiborne County School Nutrition Charge Policy). Parents are welcome to eat with their children on special occasions; however, no adults are allowed to eat at the school's cafeteria on a regular basis (Claiborne County School Nutrition Policy).
